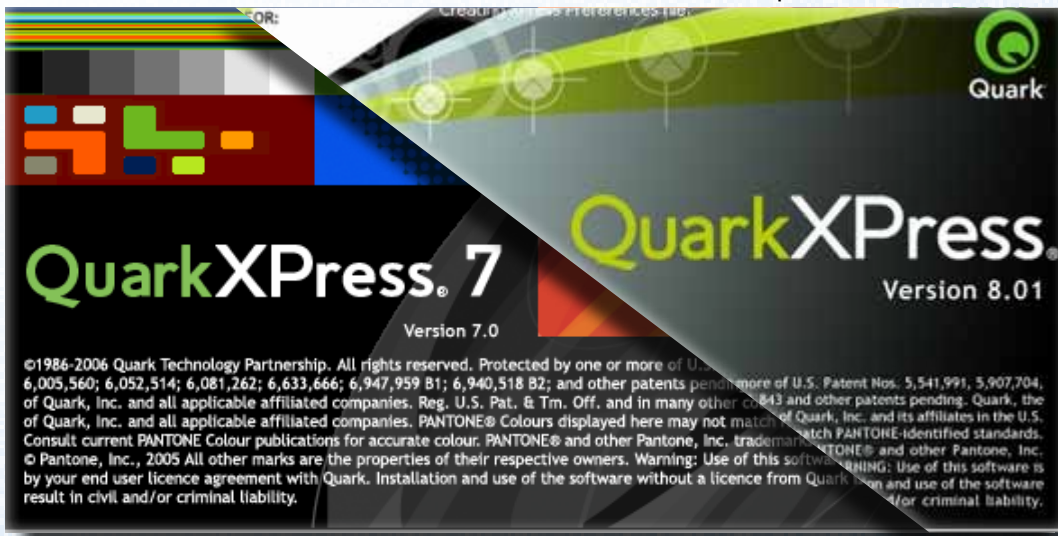

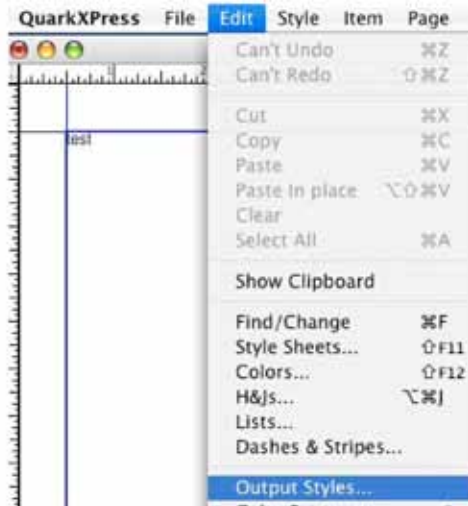
Quark 7 and Quark 8 PDF - Export Instructions

There are two methods for creating PDFs in Quark 7 and Quark 8. Both Windows and Macintosh versions taken from a Macintosh computer but the menus shown will access the needed tools in Windows as well.

1. Create PostScript for Later Distilling method is our preferred method.
2. Direct PDF Export method is also explained.

Both methods use the same preset. Import the preset first.

Import Casey Printing PDF Style

Step 1) To import Casey Printing's style, you will have downloaded an xml file accompanying this Read Me file that you will first import. Go to the Edit > Output Styles...option in Quark.



Import Casey Printing PDF Style

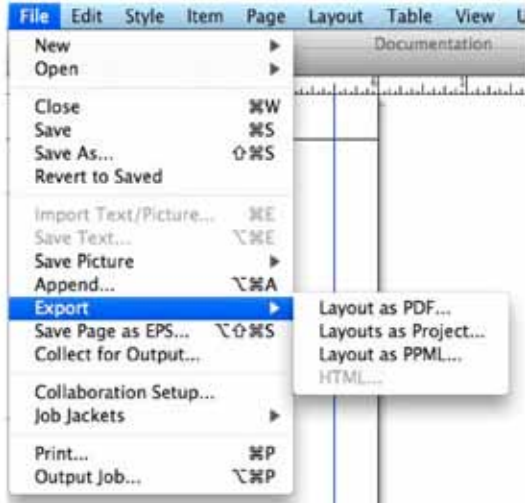
Step 2) Click on the Import button. Select the xml file called Casey PDF QXP8 or Casey PDF QXP7 in the folder you downloaded. Select it and click on the open button to complete the import. Once imported it will now show in the output styles window.

You only have to import this preset once for each Quark installation.

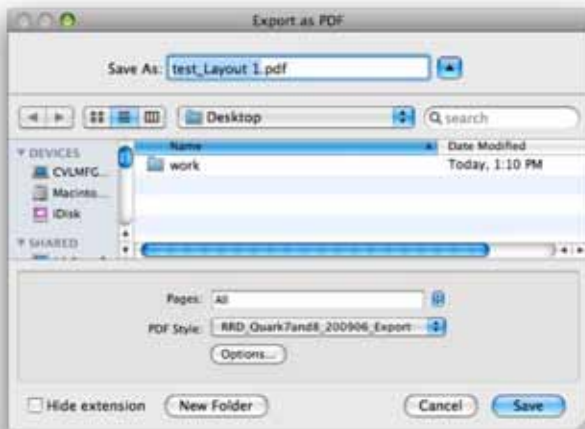

Step 1) To create a PDF file, first open your Quark file, then go to File > Export > Layout as PDF...

Step 2) Name the file. Select the Casey PDF Style from the popup menu and choose your destination folder. Then click on the Save button.
